

HAND SIGNALS

FOR DIRECTING VEHICLES

← TURNS →



Point one arm to indicate the direction to turn.



Bend monitoring arm repeatedly toward head to indicate continued turning.

DISTANCE TO STOPPING POINT



Face palms forward, with hands above head. Bring elbows forward and hands together.

ENFORM

**PROCEED SLOWLY
FORWARD BACKWARD**



Always face palms
in direction of
desired travel.



Then bend both arms
repeatedly toward head
and chest, and then extend.

CLEAR TO LEAVE AREA



Point at
the driver
and gain
eye
contact.

Turn and
extend
arms in
desired
direction.



STOP



Cross
both
arms
above
head.

EMERGENCY STOP



Start
with
hands
clapsed
over
head.

Extend downward repeatedly
until vehicle stops.
